2006 Outstanding Educator of the Year Award

In the summer of 1998, the Leadership School Planning Team created an award to recognize the achievements and contributions of teachers and leaders of particular churches within the bounds of the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina. This recognition is to be presented annually at the Leadership School/Learning Fair and is reviewed and chosen by the members of the Planning Team.

The award is to recognize accomplishments in the majority of or all of the following areas:

- 1) Meaningful contributions to the development and implementation of curriculum and resources of the Presbyterian Church (USA) within the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina.
- 2) Relevant teaching ability/skills in Christian Education
- 3) Significant leadership in Christian Education at the local church level, presbytery, or national level of the denomination
- 4) A candidate for this award should have a significant vocational and/or ecclesiastical relationship with the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina.

Nominations are solicited from members and member churches of the Presbytery of Coastal Carolina and may be made simply by a letter detailing the reasons for nomination.

The deadline for 2006 is May 31st.

A nomination should include a reasonably full survey of the nominee's contributions and work experience in Christian Education in a particular church or area. Letters of support (limit three) or other relevant information may be attached to the initial letter of nomination.

Recipient(s) will be announced at the Sept. 16th Learning Fair/Leadership School.
