From Sanford

Take Hwy 1 South then turn right onto Hwy 15/501 South. As you approach Carthage make a slight right turn onto Hwy 24/27 South (known as Monroe Street). Travel around the courthouse roundabout taking the second exit continuing on Hwy 24/27 South (which is now McReynolds Street). Take the first left onto South Ray Street and the church is located on your right across from the Post Office.

From Southern Pines/Aberdeen

Take 15/501 North. Stay in the left lane as you approach the roundabout. Take the second exit which will keep you on 15/501 North. As you enter Carthage take a left onto Hwy 22 which is McNeill Street. Enter the courthouse roundabout and take the third exit which is Hwy 24/27 (McReynolds Street). Take the first left onto South Ray Street and the church is located on your right across from the Post Office.

From Fayetteville

Take Hwy 24 West which will connect with Hwy 15/501 South. Then follow the directions coming from Sanford.
